Anti-Choking Training

Sponsored by the Beverly Health Department & Northeast Regional Ambulance

Pursuant to MGL Ch. 94, S305D, each food service establishment having a seating capacity of 25 persons or more shall: (1) Have on premises, while food is being served, an employee trained in manual procedures approved by the department to remove food lodged in a person's throat; and (2) Make adequate provision for insurance to cover employees trained in rendering such assistance. ***To assist you with compliance, the Beverly Health Department & Northeast Regional Ambulance will sponsor this cost effective and convenient anti-choking training:***
