EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING FINES FOR VIOLATIONS OF COVID-19 EMERGENCY ORDERS

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2020, United States Health and Human Services Secretary Alex M. Azar, II, declared a public health emergency for the entire United States to aid the nation's healthcare community in responding to the 2019 novel Coronavirus ("COVID-19"); and

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, Massachusetts Governor Charles D. Baker issued a proclamation that a State of Emergency exists in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to respond to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 11, 2020, the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 a pandemic; and

WHEREAS, on March 13, 2020, President Donald J. Trump declared a national emergency to respond to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, Mayor Michael P. Cahill declared a state of emergency in the City of Beverly to respond to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, the Board of Health declared a Public Health Emergency in the City of Beverly to respond to COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Health has issued Emergency Orders pursuant to 310 CMR 11.05 and G.L. c. 111, §30, to prepare for, prevent, respond to, and mitigate damage to public health that may otherwise result from the spread of COVID-19, dated April 5, 2020 (Evictions and Inspections, Pedestrian Traffic on Lothrop Street Sidewalks), April 10, 2020 (Face Covering), and April 24, 2020 (Revised Face Covering, Revised Evictions and Inspections) ("COVID-19 Orders");

NOW THEREFORE, COVID-19 Orders shall be enforced by the method provided in M.G.L. c. 40, § 21D, and City of Beverly Ordinance § 1-6, Noncriminal Disposition of Violations. The noncriminal fines for each such violation shall be:


- First violation: \$50.00
- Second violation: \$100.00
- Third or subsequent violation: \$150.00

The Board of Health, acting through its emergency agent and his designees, and officers of the Beverly Police Department shall be considered enforcing persons in accordance with City of Beverly Ordinance § 1-6.

This Emergency Order shall be effective at 12:00 p.m. Friday, April 24, 2020, and shall remain in effect until notice is given, pursuant to the Board of Health's judgment, that the Public Health Emergency no longer exists.
