REVISED EMERGENCY ORDER REGARDING FACE COVERING IN ESSENTIAL RETAIL SERVICES, RESTAURANTS, BARS, AND OTHER RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS THAT SELL FOOD AND BEVERAGE PRODUCTS TO THE PUBLIC, AND RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL BUIDLINGS, AND ORDER REGARDING PROHIBITION ON ICE CREAM TRUCKS AND SALES

The Emergency Order Regarding Face Coverings issued by the Beverly Board of Health, dated April 10, 2020, Paragraph 3, is amended to read as follows:

3. This order does not relieve an employer or employee from any other rule, law or regulation that requires, advises, and/or recommends the use or non-use of a particular type of mask or face covering for a particular job, nor is it intended to create a requirement that is inconsistent with such.

Further, the April 10, 2020, Emergency Order Regarding Face Coving shall not apply to persons under the age of two (2) years or anyone who has trouble breathing, or is unconscious, incapacitated, or otherwise unable to remove the mask without assistance.

This Emergency Order shall be effective at 12:00 p.m. Friday, April 24, 2020, and shall remain in effect until notice is given, pursuant to the Board of Health's judgment, that the Public Health Emergency no longer exists.
